Shri Madhukarrao Bapurao Patil Khatgaonkar College, Shankarnagar is established in 1991 as a part of the social commitment. The main objective of the organisation is to provide higher education to the rural sections of the society. The college has obtained 2(f) & 12-B recognition by UGC. The college possesses C++ grade in NAAC cycle-I.

The college is dedicated to the allround personality development of the students. The college staff is involved in innovative activities in teaching, learning and evaluation process. The result is that twenty-four teachers have been given Ph. D. by University. Most of the faculty members are engaged in post-doctoral research activities. Twelve faculty members are research guides. Twenty-seven scholars hold Ph. D. under the supervision of the faculty. Moreover, forty-four research scholars are enrolled. Eight faculty members have acquired M. Phil. degree. Three faculty members have cleared NET. Five of the staff members are working as BOS members. The college has been extending in a proper way to maintain the good academic standard. Furthermore, the college has undertaken various society oriented activities to fulfil the institutional social responsibility.

The college has been bestowed B grade with 2.31 CGPA in 2016 by NAAC. In pursuance of quality enhancement process, the college organized four university-level workshops on new curriculum of the University. A National Conference in Public Administration was also organized by IQAC. The Institution is determined to adopt a strategic approach to meet the requirements of the students and the society around.

B. Institutional Weaknesses

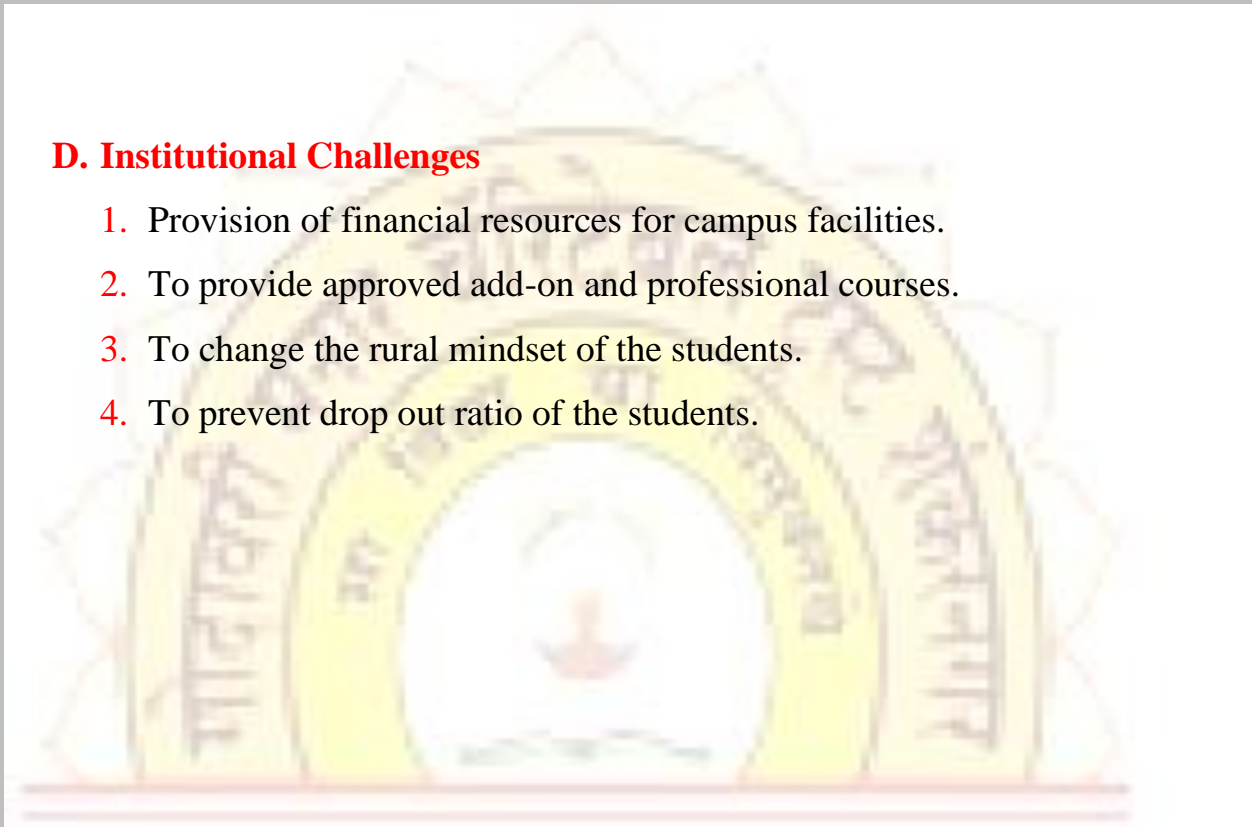
1. Lack of Govt. funding for maintenance and provision of campus facilities.
